BDS Architects and Corvus Design Landscape Architecture and Planning have been contracted by the University of Alaska Fairbanks to develop a Trails and Greenways plan for the lower west por•on of the UAF campus (see map below for our project area). The purpose of the plan will be to priori•ze improvements and the preserva•on and connec•on of open spaces and greenways in the general area of Lower West Ridge Campus, with a focus on suppor•ng recrea•onal uses, pedestrian pathways, and areas of cultural/historical signi•cance.

The general area of study includes, but is not limited to, the open areas surrounding the Wood Center, Student Recrea•onal Center (SRC), Butrovich/IAB Greenhouse Hill, Troth Yeddha, Museum of the North, Townshend Point, and Botanical Gardens/Farm. Special a•en•on will be paid to the Chancellor's Trail Ini•a•ve (West Ridge to Main Campus Trail), the adapta•on of Cutler Apartment Complex to undergraduate housing, and the connec•ons between campus and o• campus nodes, like the Cold Climate Housing Research Center and Sustainable Village.
