



"Me? Homesick? Not too much--I'm used to it!" Diane Ferris, who resided in Stebens, Alaska for nearly 15 years, says.

She's been here since 1975, when she and her husband, Jim, moved from California to the tiny town of 1,000 people. They had just sold their house in Sacramento, Calif., and were looking for a place to live where they could raise their two sons, now 18 and 20. "We wanted to get away from the city," says Diane, 47, who has three other children, ages 22, 20 and 17, from previous marriages. "We wanted to live in a place where we could have a garden and raise our own food."

They found it in Stebens, a town that sits at the base of the Chugach Mountains, about 100 miles west of Anchorage. "It's a great place to live," says Diane, who loves the outdoors and enjoys snowshoeing, cross-country skiing and hiking. "There's a lot of wildlife here, like moose, caribou, bear, fox, marmots and porcupines."

But Diane's life in Alaska hasn't been without its challenges. She says she's had to learn how to live off the land, grow her own food and hunt for game. "It's a different way of life," she says. "You have to be self-sufficient. You can't just go to the store and buy what you need."

She's also had to learn how to deal with the weather. "It can get very cold here, especially in the winter," she says. "The temperature can drop below zero, and it can stay cold for weeks at a time. You have to be prepared for anything."

But Diane says she's happy with her decision to move to Alaska. "It's a beautiful place, and I love living here," she says. "I've made many friends here, and I feel like I belong. It's a great place to live, and I wouldn't trade it for anything."

She says she's also learned a lot about herself since moving to Alaska. "I've had to learn how to be more independent and self-sufficient," she says. "I've had to learn how to take care of myself and my family. It's been a challenge, but it's also been a rewarding experience."


Fred Daniels is a sixteen year old senior from Alaska. He was born in Elim on April 8, 19






