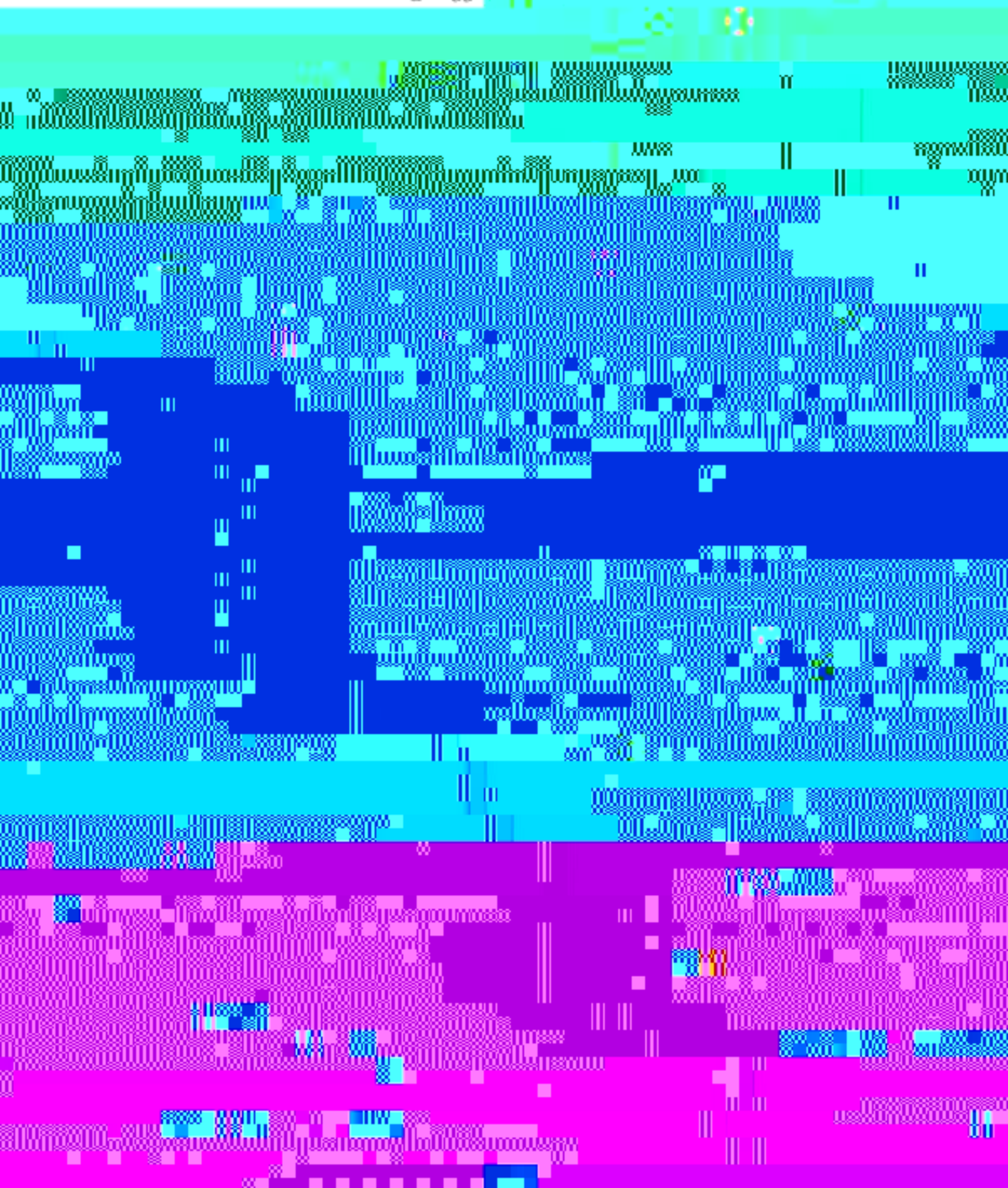






## RAHI: Heading Off

Alaskan teachers and students, as well as scientists, conducting each a different project.

They spent about 40 hours per week working in a lab of a scientist at UAF and attending seminars. Students are able to explain the theoretical basis of current techniques such as sequencing, electroporation and microarray technology.

Students were selected by application based upon a high degree of interest in science, a strong academic performance, among other qualifications.

The project is sponsored by the UAF Institute of Arctic Biology with funds from the National Science Foundation.

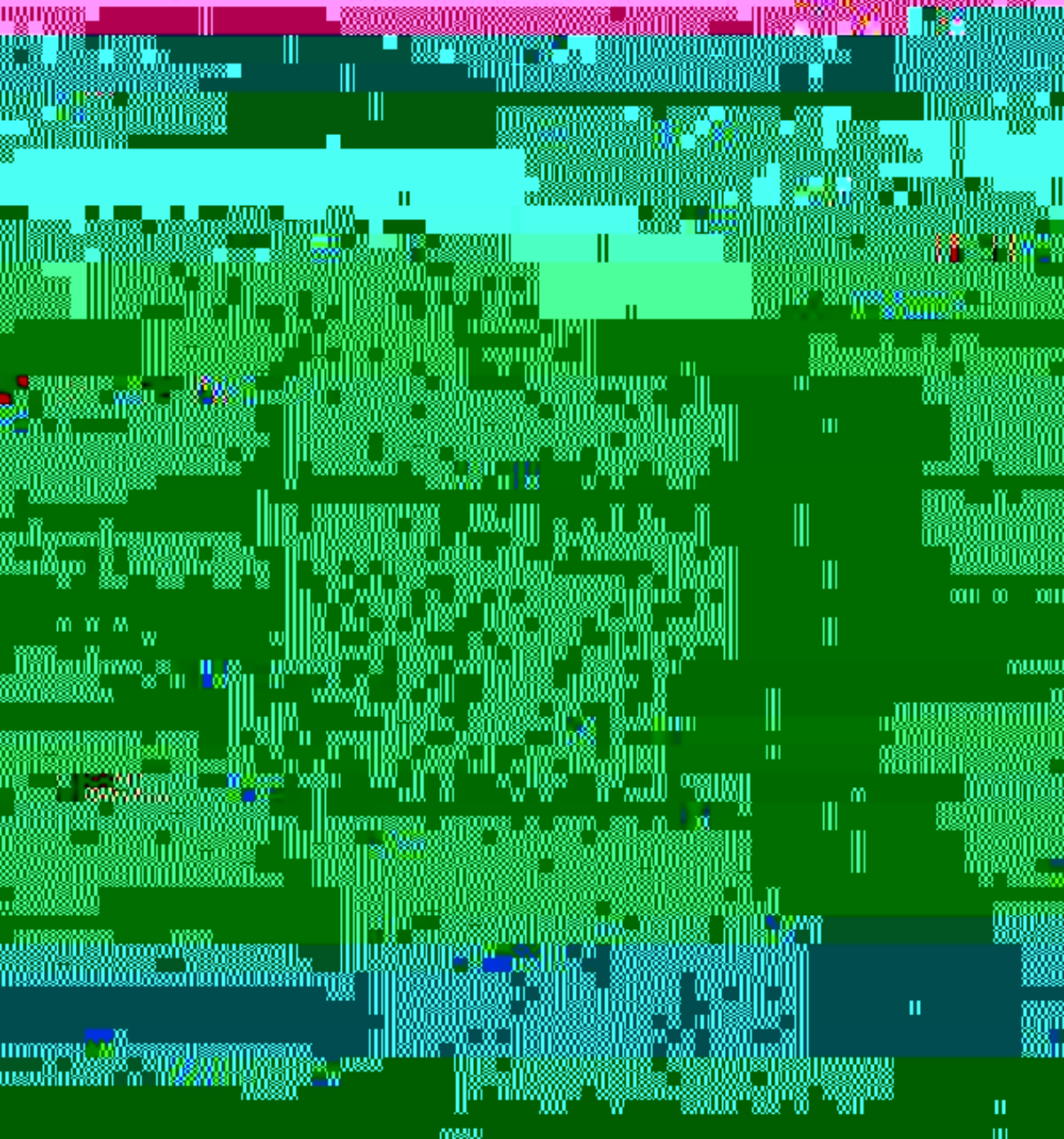

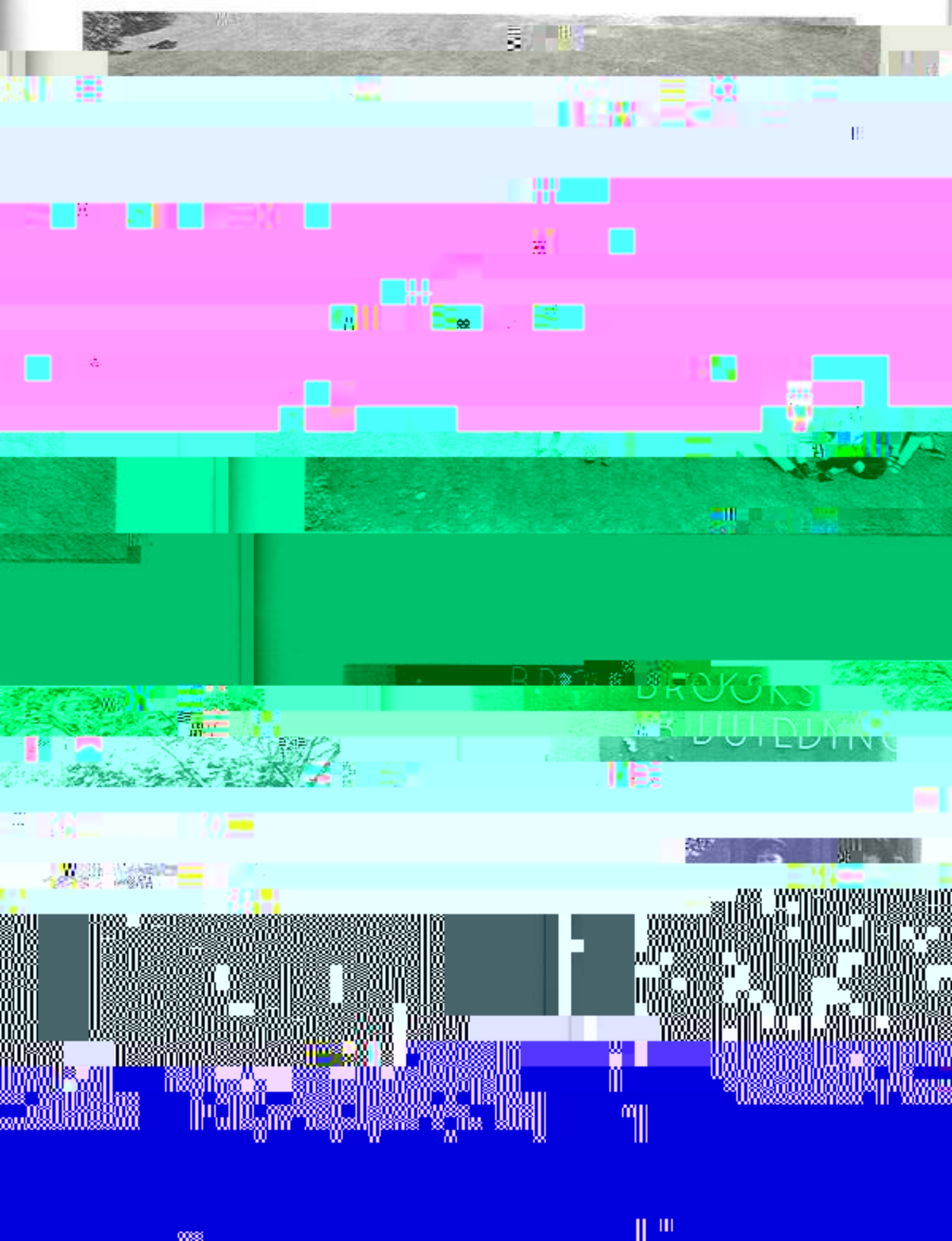

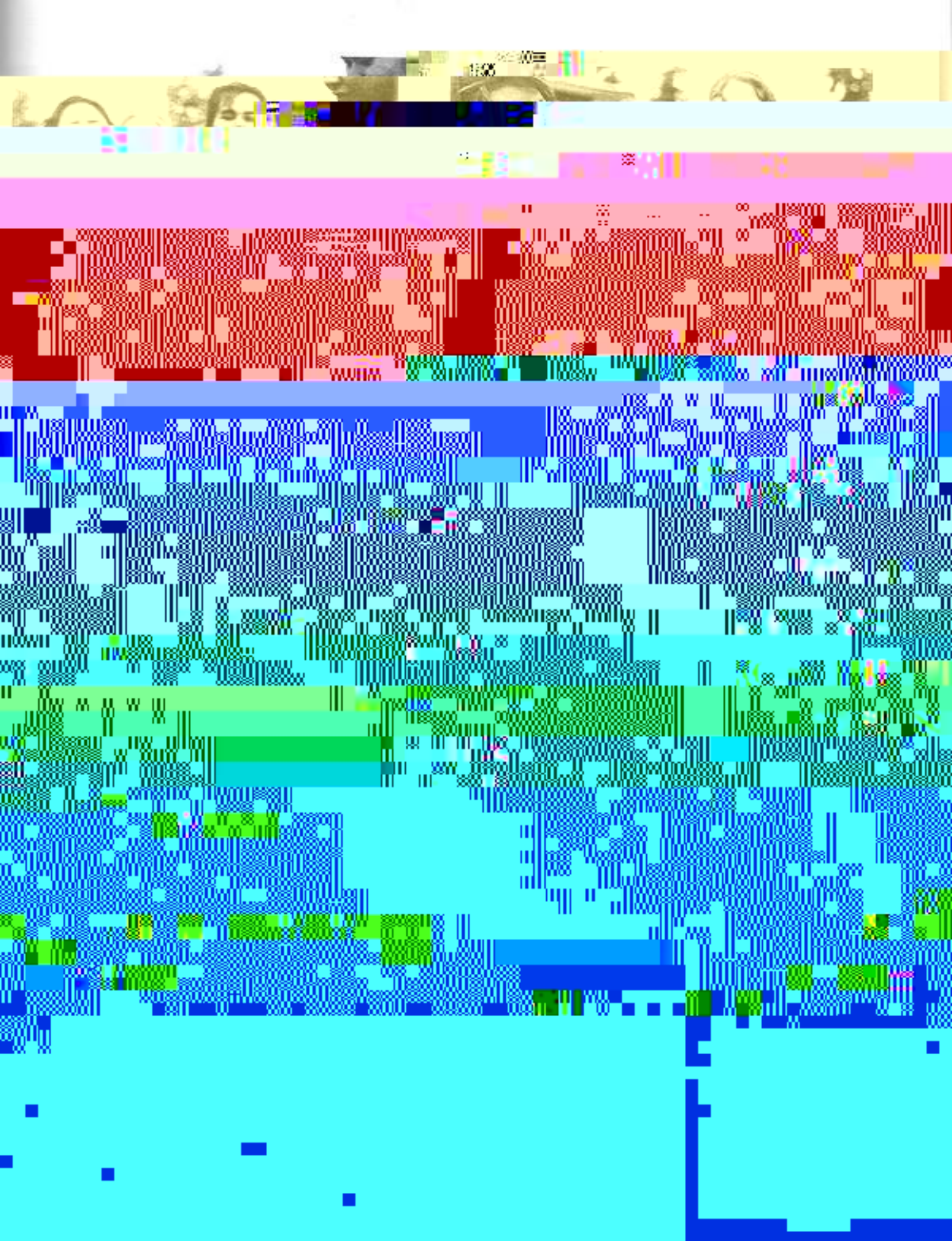
