Quarantine & testing protocols under review with Omicron

Logistics and transportation expected to operate closer to normal, but with some COVID adaptations – no Prudhoe Bay pick up

Population will be capped at ~108 (single bed per room)

Kitchen operations will be back to normal

Northbound trucks may shift to Thursday/Friday, for test results

~32 projects expected to be present at, including 24 N SF/Battelle-A RO supported projects.

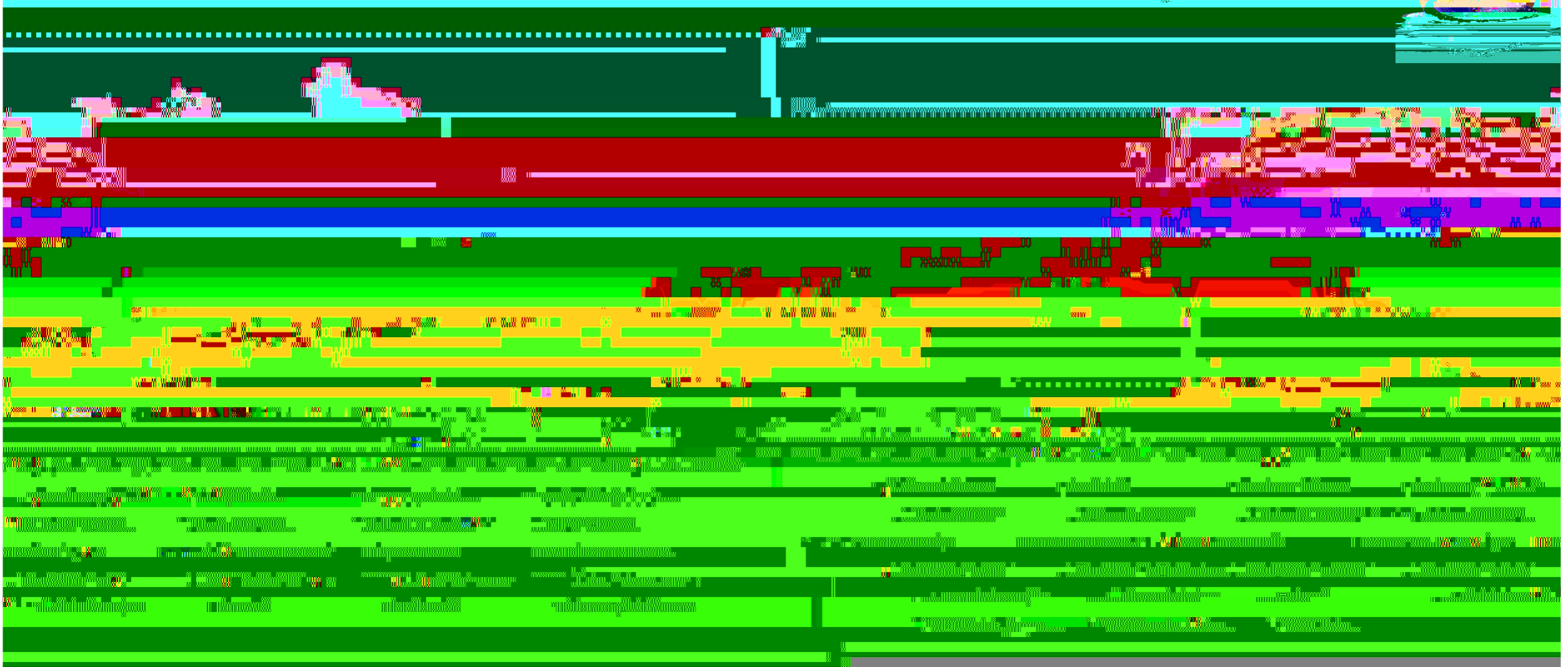
10 new projects in 2022

SAFETY - PRE-TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS



8-day quarantine for fully-vaccinated travelers compliant with CDC booster guidance

Facility organized by Battelle ARO for all NSF supported projects

1 negative NAAT COVID test (PCR, TMA)

Day 5

Temperature screening on the day of departure

SAFETY - PRE-TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

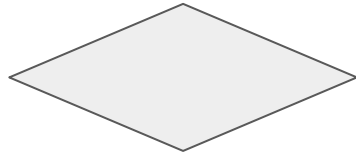
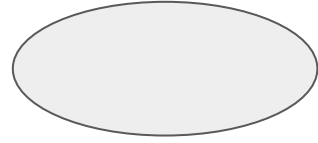


10-day quarantine for those without vaccinations or boosters (if applicable)

NAAT test on day 6

Those who have not received a primary COVID-19 vaccination series must possess a valid medical or religious exemption form from their home institution or primary care physician

Failure to do so will prevent said individual from traveling to TFS





SAFETY - PRE-TRAVEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Solo outdoor recreation will be permitted

Isolated to areas within immediate walking distance from quarantine facility

Potential for members of the same household or lab group to quarantine together

Note: One positive test flags everyone quarantining in the "pod"

SAFETY - IN-CAMP COVID POLICIES

Masks no longer mandatory

Frequent sanitation of dining facility surfaces

1 resident per room

Possible exception for members of the same household or couples

Note: One positive test flags everyone in the "pod"



SAFETY - FUTURE COVID PLANS

Policies have the potential to change as future information becomes available
