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The Curricular Affairs Committee moves that the Faculty Senate submit the following changes to the UAF general education policy for a faculty vote of approval:

General Education Requirements

Students will take the following:

- One course in the Natural Sciences (4 credits; includes a lab)
- One course in Mathematics (3-4 credits)
- One course in the Arts (3 credits)
- Two courses in the Social Sciences (6 credits)
- Two courses in the Humanities (6 credits)
- Two courses in Writing (6 credits; currently courses satisfying this requirement are English 111X, English 211X/English 213X)
- One course in Communication (3 credits; current courses that satisfy this requirement are COMM 121X/COMM 131X/COMM 141X)
- One Quantitative Literacy course; anywhere across the curriculum (3-4 credits)
- LS 101 as a pre- or co-requisite with

Each student must take one course which possesses each of these attributes:

- (E) Civic Engagement (3 credits)
- (A) Alaska and the Circumpolar North (3 credits)
- (D) Intercultural Competence and Diversity (3 credits)
