 7. Course must be offered regularly as described in the catalog (at least once per year).

Humanities Guidelines

University Regulation: "Introduce the student to the humanistic fields of language, arts, literature, history, and philosophy."

1. Course must be 100 or 200 level.
2. Course has an introductory component.
3. Humanities field addressed in the course should be identified.
4. No pre-requisites other than ENGL 111x, including implicit pre-requisites.
