

How does the program relate to the Education mission of the University of Alaska and the MAU? This proposed program is a 15 credit graduate certificate in construction management that will provide advanced training for graduate engineers and other professionals in the Alaskan construction workforce. The program was developed in close coordination with Alaska construction industry employers and envisions continuing that relationship with employers sponsoring courses, providing classroom space, and participating in an industry advisory committee.

*Who promoted the development of the program?

The program developed from the convergence of three trends: 1. UAF engineering's goal of increasing graduate-level courses for working engineers; 2. the nationwide trend of graduate engineering programs to "package" their graduate offerings for particular industries; and 3. the Alaska Department of Transportation's (DOT) need to provide advanced training for its engineers and other professionals who are making decisions that affect the physical and economic wellbeing of Alaskans.
