Dependent Audit:

Open enrollment is April 15tMay 16th. Every will have to participate in open enrollment as there are significant changes to the plan, in both design and name. The rates payroll contributed tier schedule will remain the same.

The Tobacco Surcharge:

The UA administration is in agreement with the recommendation of the Joint Health Care Committee to encourage employees who use tobacco to consider tobacco cessation programs over the course of the next year, before a different charge begins in FY13. Tobacco cessation programs will be identified for employees' participation, and there will be no cost to employees for these programs.
