UAF Health and Safety Policy (Office of Research Integrity)

The UAF Health and Safety Policy is designed to provide a framework for the management and control of health and safety risks in the workplace. The policy is based on the principles of prevention and control, and is intended to provide a clear and concise statement of the University's commitment to the health and safety of its employees and students.

The policy is organized into several sections, including:

- 1. Purpose and Scope
- 2. Management and Worker Responsibilities
- 3. Training and Education
- 4. Hazard Identification and Assessment
- 5. Control Measures
- 6. Incident Investigation and Reporting
- 7. Record Keeping
- 8. Review and Revision

The UAF Health and Safety Policy is a living document that will be reviewed and updated as needed to reflect changes in the workplace and in the state of the art in health and safety practice. The policy is intended to provide a clear and concise statement of the University's commitment to the health and safety of its employees and students.

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
