UAF Health and Safety Policy

The University of Alaska Fairbanks (UAF) is committed to providing a safe and healthy work environment for all employees, students, and visitors. This policy outlines the responsibilities of management and workers to ensure the highest level of safety and health protection.

Management is responsible for providing a safe and healthy work environment, including:

- Establishing and maintaining a safe and healthy work environment.
- Providing training and education to employees on safety and health issues.
- Providing necessary resources and equipment to ensure safety and health.
- Investigating and reporting incidents and injuries.

Workers are responsible for:

- Following all safety and health rules and regulations.
- Using proper safety and health practices.
- Reporting any safety and health concerns to management.

This policy applies to all UAF employees, students, and visitors. It is the responsibility of all individuals to read and understand this policy and to follow its provisions. Management will provide training and education to ensure that all individuals understand their responsibilities under this policy.

The UAF Health and Safety Policy is a living document and will be updated as needed to reflect changes in regulations, technology, and best practices. Management will ensure that all employees, students, and visitors are kept informed of any updates to this policy.

UAF Health and Safety Policy is a key component of UAF's commitment to safety and health. It provides a framework for managing safety and health risks and ensuring that all individuals are protected from harm. Management will continue to work with employees, students, and visitors to improve safety and health performance and create a culture of safety and health.

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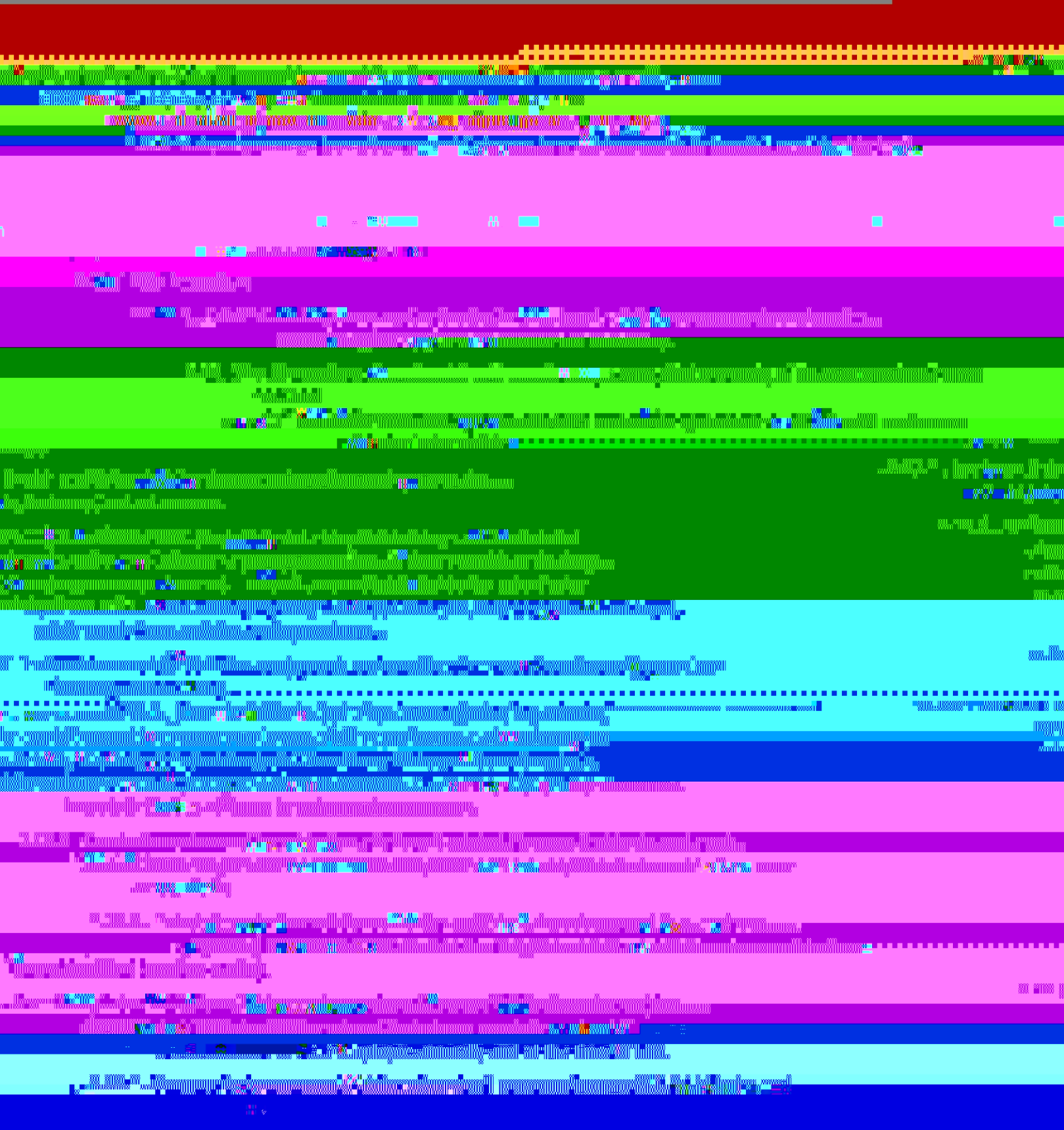
